Christ to the World Ministries began its outreach in Korea sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ in 2004. We began with our broadcast partner, the Far East Broadcasting Corporation (FEBC), the translation and production of the radio drama series, *Persons Who Met Jesus* and *Easter* and *Christmas* radio drama special programs, and are preparing to produce a new program series: *The Life of Jesus Christ.* Each series is translated and produced in the Korean language from our FEBC-Seoul production studios. We believe many hundreds of thousands of listeners hear and understand the message of Jesus Christ each day through the effective and diverse programming of FEBC. Many individuals and families have come to know the one and only true God and accept Christ as Savior and Lord. It takes courage and is a walk of faith for many who come from a home where other family members are rooted in a different faith, many being Buddhist.

Our prayer is that many in Korea will come to know Christ through our broadcast ministry and be included in that great multitude.

**Country Profile:** South Korea is a country of over 46 million homogeneous people. We believe that in a country where literacy is nearly 99%, reaching everyday people by radio and a fast-growing Internet broadcast and pod cast of the radio drama stories of Jesus will yield great results. In a country so fast-paced, the opportunity to make a real impact in sharing the gospel is ever present and growing. Praise God for the Christian leaders and the unique and growing churches throughout South Korea. With an estimated 31% of the country being Christian, South Korea represents the largest percentage of Christians and Protestant churches per capita than any other Asian country, and has set the standard for Bible training, missionary training and outreach. Korean Christians are known for being passionate about prayer and commitment.
